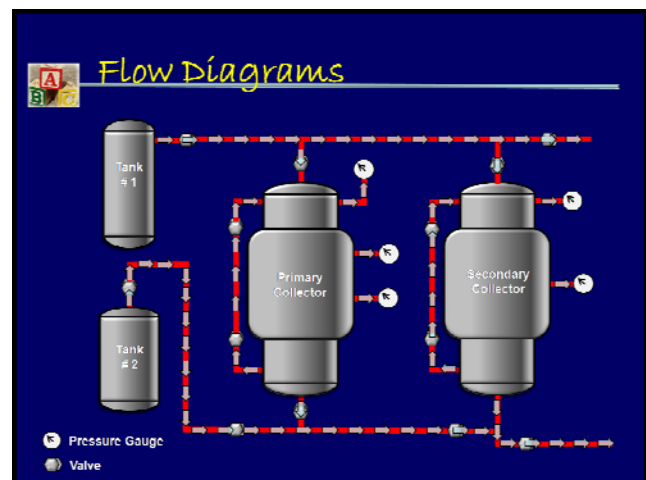
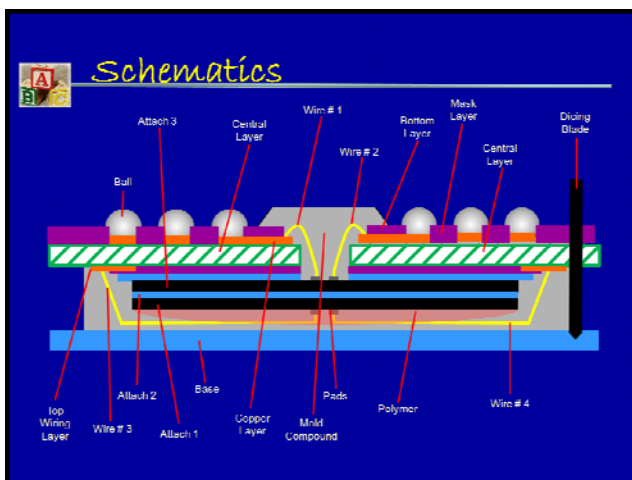


Using PowerPoint for Trial Support

Using PowerPoint for Trial Support will show attendees how to use PowerPoint software to benefit clients. The user will learn what to use and not to use with regard to certain software functionalities and will also learn how to create clear and concise graphic messages. Most importantly, the user will be able to do this in-house to reduce outside vendor expenditures. The presentation will include numerous exhibit types created exclusively in PowerPoint. Finally, there is a brief discussion of how to work within the court system to assure that effective graphic messages are presented at trial including a description of presentation equipment.

PowerPoint is a powerful litigation tool that few in the legal community have traditionally utilized for preparing trial exhibits. PowerPoint is also thought of as being a linear presentation media, meaning that one has to present in slide order; this is not the case. However, with a little inquisitiveness on the part of the user and a willingness to go through a brief learning curve, the true value of PowerPoint will be revealed during this presentation.
